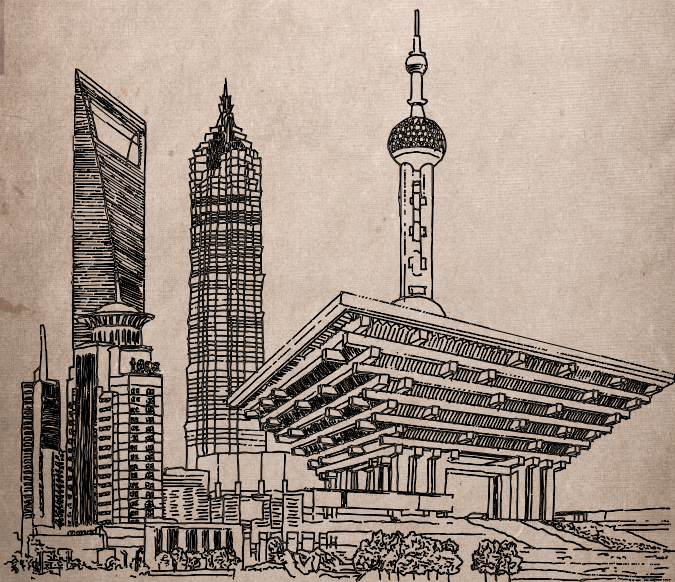

72-hour visa exemption transit at the Shanghai Port

Approved by the State Council in a written reply, as of Jan.1, 2013, the policy of 72-hour visa exemption transit at the Shanghai port became applicable to the citizens from the 45 countries. The citizens from the 45 countries, holding their valid international travel permit, visa to the on-going third country (region)、round-trip air tickets with confirmed date and seat assignment exiting within 72 hours or other relevant document, may enjoy visa exemption transit stay at the Shanghai aviation port (Pudong International Airport and Hongqiao International Airport) in the Shanghai administrative region not exceeding 72 hours.

72-hour visa exemption transit inspection area and special pass have been set up by Shanghai Exit & Entry Frontier Inspection Organ at Pudong International Airport and Hongqiao International Airport so as to facilitate transit passengers with quality and speedy service.

72-hour visa-exemption transit policy is valid for passport holders from the following countries:

Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Russia, the United Kingdom, Ireland, Cyprus, Bulgaria, Romania, Ukraine, the United States, Canada, Brazil, Mexico, Argentina, Chile, Australia, New Zealand, South Korea, Japan, Singapore, Brunei, the United Arab Emirates, Qatar.





1、 From what countries travelers may enjoy and apply for 72-hour transit visa exemption?

According to the regulation formulated by the Public Security Ministry, foreign nationals when arriving at Shanghai port may apply for transit procedures if their applications meet the requirement and approved after examination by Shanghai Frontier Inspection Department.

- ★ Tourists who hold passports issued by the above-listed 45 countries;
- ★ Tourists who hold valid international travel documents;
- ★ Tourists who qualify for the entry requirements of their third destination country;
- ★ Tourists who hold valid plane tickets with 72-hour validation and transit from Shanghai Port to the third destinations;
- ★ Tourists who have been reported to Chinese Frontier Inspection Organization by their airline companies.

2、 Can a foreign national apply for 72-hour transit visa exemption when no air ticket is bought at the time of entry but he or she plans to purchase the air ticket for a third country leaving 72 hours after entry?

According to the 72-hour transit visa exemption regulations, a foreign national is requested to hold the air ticket for a connecting flight with confirmed date and seat or relevant document and at the same time the exit air ticket is already in place before entry. Therefore, no this policy is applicable to a foreign national holding no confirmed 72-hour air ticket for a connecting flight.

3、 Can a foreign national from the above-mentioned countries enter the port by train from a railway station and then take a flight out within 72 hours?

The present policy of "72-hour transit visa exemption" is only applicable at Shanghai port, that is, transit application handled at Pudong International Airport and Hongqiao International Airport in Shanghai.

4、 Does this policy applicable to a foreign national coming to Shanghai from a certain country of the above-mentioned countries with a confirmed air ticket for flying back to the same country where he or she comes from within 72 hours with confirmed date of flight and seat?

According to the regulations, the policy of "72-hour transit visa exemption" is applicable to a foreign national from the above-mentioned countries having a transit in Shanghai and on-going to a third country or region. Therefore, this policy is not applicable to a foreign national whose on-going country is as the same in-coming country.

5、 Can a foreign national leave-Shanghai' s administrative precinct after getting 72-hour transit visa exemption?

A foreign national after getting 72-hour transit visa exemption is not allowed to leave the administrative precinct of Shanghai. In case of need to leave the administrative precinct of Shanghai by special factor of force majeure, the foreign national must apply for a visa to the exit-entry administrative department of Shanghai Municipal Public Security Bureau as required by law.

6、What should be done in case a foreign national who has the 72-hour transit visa exemption can not leave Shanghai within 72 hours due to some special reason after entry?

A foreign national after getting 72-hour transit visa exemption is requested to leave within the permitted time of stay. The passenger can leave the country after applying for a relevant visa at the exit-entry administrative department of Shanghai Municipal Public Security Bureau if the stay is longer than 72 hours due to the reason of force majeure.

7、It is known that this policy of 72-hour transit visa exemption is also implemented at Beijing port. Can a foreign national getting 72-hour transit visa exemption leave Beijing after the entry in Shanghai?

A foreign national with 72-hour transit visa exemption is not allowed to leave the city where the stop over is permitted. Therefore, a foreign national obtaining 72-hour tourist visa exemption at Shanghai airport shall leave China from the same airport within the permitted time of stay.

8、How can I ask for more information if I have more questions concerning the policy of the frontier inspection?

9、Any regulations by the Customs on inspection and release after examination to “72-hour visa exemption transit passengers?”

★ Transit passengers, leaving or not leaving the supervised area of the Customs, are not allowed to carry any articles prohibited by the People's Republic of China upon entry and exit.

★ In accordance with the No.72 Bulletin by the Customs Head Office in 2007 passengers should declare to the Customs all the articles that should be declared.

★ Release after examination regulation of luggage and articles carried by passengers
Luggage and articles carried by transit passengers leaving the Customs supervised area during their transit period are handled by the Customs accordingly.

Luggage and articles carried by transit passengers are only for their own needs. Transit passengers of multiple visits in a non-short-period are allowed to carry, for their own use, camera, mini-televicamera, portable recording camera and portable computer, one for each variety, and other personal articles necessary during their travel with the approval from the Customs. The articles as regulated by the Customs are duty free, but must be carried out by passengers upon their exit. import tax is levied by the Customs on the articles for personal use with the value of more than 2,000 RMB. Cigarette and wine and other 20 non-duty-free varieties of articles are handled according to the relevant regulation. Articles exceeding the relevant regulations are not allowed to carry in and kept by the Customs for the time-being. They should be carried out by passengers at their original entry port.

10、Any regulations by China Inspection & Quarantine Bureau applicable to the entry passengers?

Transit foreign passengers are not allowed to carried in animals and plants and relevant products as listed in the “Catalogue of Animals & Plants Prohibited by the People's Republic of China. They must abide by Chinese laws and other relevant regulations.

★ Foreign nationals, taking up lodgings at other residence instead of hotels, are requested to make registration within 24 hours at the nearest police station.

★ "72-hour visa exemption" transit foreign passengers are allowed to take part in activities only in the Shanghai area, and are strictly requested to leave Shanghai at scheduled time.

★ During tour in China, they are requested to carry passport and other documents with them for inspection, if necessary.

★ Foreign nationals enjoying visa exemption transit are requested to apply for relevant visa in time at Shanghai Public Security Bureau Exit & Entry Administration Office in case their stay exceeds 72 hours because of the factor of force majeure.
